

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES – JANUARY/FEBRUARY 2016



Construction Progress

Construction is moving forward on the north end of Terry Avenue. Electrical has been put in place for the streetlights; however, the actual streetlights have not yet been installed. Milling work has begun on the eastern end of Livingston near Hughey Avenue. Trees and landscaping materials should be put in place in the next month.

Lime Line: Freshly Squeezed Starting January 24, 2016

Beginning Sunday, January 24, the new LYMMO Lime Line will begin service. This first launch of service is **limited** and includes new stops at FAMU College of Law, U.S. District Courthouse and the intersection of Robinson Street and Garland Avenue. Construction of new road segments will be completed in August 2016 and will add two additional stops in the Creative Village area.
