



## It Takes A Village

Creative Village is an exemplary public-private partnership between the master developer (Creative Village Development, LLC) and the City of Orlando, led by Mayor Buddy Dyer. This urban Innovation District positively impacts the West Side of Downtown Orlando.

The master development team coordinates numerous initiatives to address key community, social and economic factors including a variety of housing types, access to public education, parks and open space, mobility and transportation choices and economic development.

From the onset, significant consideration was given to the surrounding Parramore neighborhood while setting forth a long-term framework for responsible mixed-use development of a "live, work, learn, play" district.

Creative Village is home to the UCF Downtown and Valencia College Downtown campus. Once an area of disinvestment with a lack of resources, Parramore is now home to a robust education ecosystem. The "Cradle to Career" model provides opportunity and access to a historically underserved community and enables traditionally underprivileged youth a path to succeed.

Creative Village Phase I was completed in 2022.






### Make Your Mark Here

#### Center for Accelerated Training Downtown Orlando

Valencia College Accelerated Skills Training programs at Creative Village focus on intensive, hands-on training and are designed to help participants further their skills by gaining experience using the newest tools in the field and earn nationally recognized certifications.



The Princeton Review ranked UCF's Florida Interactive Entertainment Academy (FIEA) among the Best in the World for 2023. This is the fourth consecutive year in the top two for the graduate game design program.

In 2022, Electronic Arts announced the first two recipients of the "Inclusion in Gaming Endowed Scholarship": Luis Santiago, a UCF games and interactive media undergraduate student and Adrienne Boatright '22, a digital media alum currently pursuing a master's in interactive entertainment at UCF FIEA.

As part of its ongoing Community Action Plan, Electronic Arts aims to diversify the growing gaming industry by supporting the success of students at UCF.


